TABE TEST

TABE testing takes approximately 90 minutes and requires

- a \$30 fee, *no personal checks*
- A picture ID
- Minimum age of 16
- TABE results are ready immediately after completion

DO NOT BRING YOUR CELL PHONE INTO THE TESTING ROOM.

Cell phones, Electronic Devices, Notes, and/or Calculators are **NOT allowed** in the room. Use of these devices or a ringing/vibrating phone will result in the **INVALIDATION** of your test.

Testing Accommodations – If you are requesting testing accommodations, please contact the school at 239-334-4544 prior to testing. Medical documentation of the disability (dated within the last 2 years) must be provided.

Effective 01/01/2019:
All students who have not met the requirements of their chosen program under TABE Test 9/10 must retest using TABE Test 11/12 and meet its requirements

Beginning 01/01/19:

The TABE Test 11/12 is in sections. The **Locator Section** must be taken first and is **Only** offered on **Mondays**

Tuesdays:

TABE Test: *Math Sections (2)*

Wednesdays:

TABE Test: *Reading & Language Section*

Exemptions

The following are the only circumstances from which you can be exempt from taking the TABE:

1. You have an **Associate of Science degree, an Associate of Arts degree** or higher.
2. You **graduated** from a Florida **public** high school since 2007 with a **standard** high school diploma.
3. You **previously took the TABE** at another institution either in Florida or out of state within **two years** of the start date of your program and have appropriate scores for your program of interest.
4. You have **ACT/SAT/PERT/Accuplacer** scores earned within two years of the start date of your program that are equivalent to TABE scores. (See the Admissions Officer to confirm this.)
5. You have earned the **GED** *within two years* of the start date of your program.

Students applying for **Practical Nursing** need to **take** the **Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS)** *even if they are exempt from the TABE.*

FMTC TABE RETEST POLICY

Fort Myers Technical College adheres to all recommended testing policies established by the **Florida Department of Education, The American Psychological Association (APA), and the National Reporting System (NRS)**. The retest for each level may be taken **no sooner than three months** from the original test date unless the student has enrolled in remediation classes. If the student retests without remediation after the 90-day period and is again unsuccessful on the TABE, the student must enroll in remediation before retaking the test.

Adult students who do not score a minimum of 6th grade level will be recommended to take the TABE Locator in order to determine remediation options.

Students requiring remediation based on TABE results will participate in the Applied Academics for Adult Education (AAAE) program:

1. Students who need to register for the AAAE Learning Center should see an Admissions Officer.
2. An individual study program will be developed.
3. Upon completion of remediation, the student will retest only on the needed subtest(s) in the AAAE learning center.
