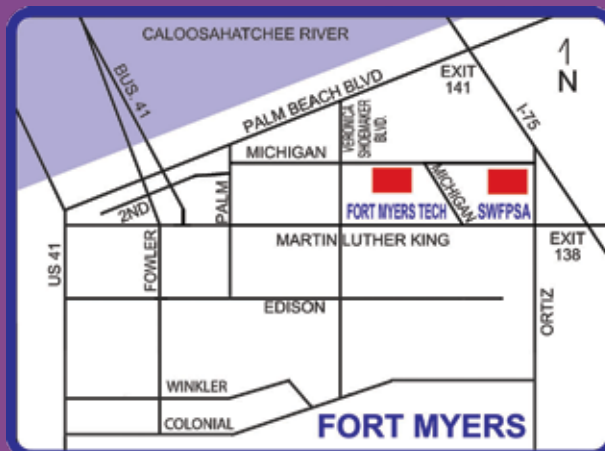

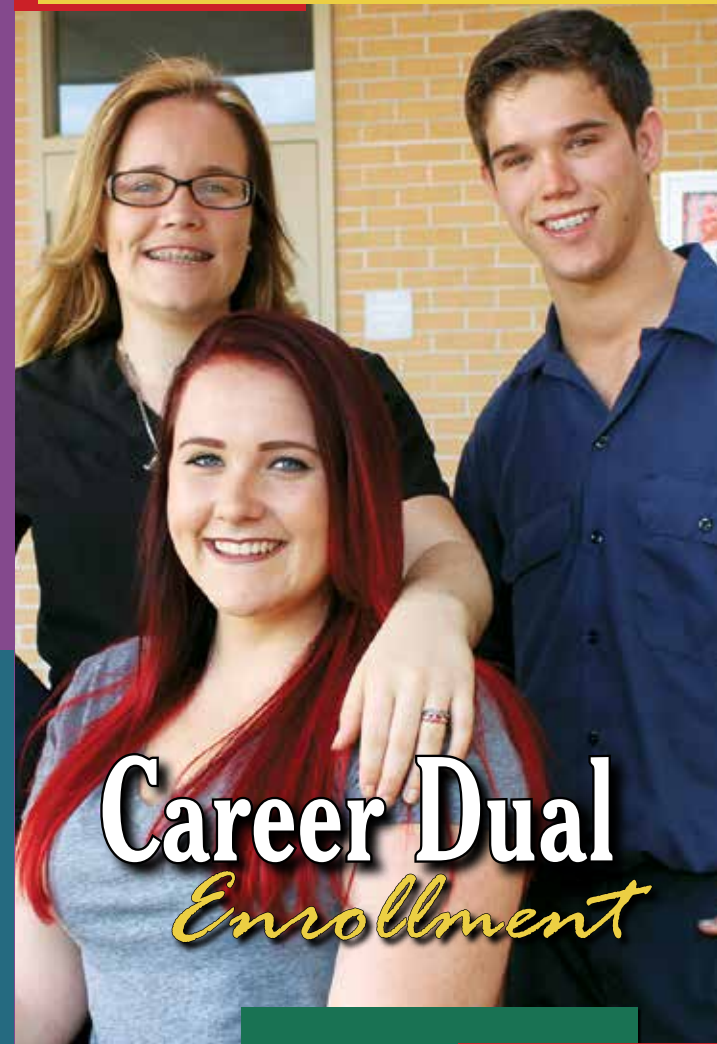

# CAREER DUAL Enrollment



## What is Career Dual Enrollment?

Career dual enrollment is an option for high school students to enroll in postsecondary courses creditable toward both high school graduation and a career and technical program certificate. Students enrolled in career dual enrollment may earn industry certifications and articulated college credit toward AAS/AS degrees in state colleges and universities.

## Requirements

In order to dual enroll, a student must meet these minimum requirements:

- ❖ Maintain a minimum of a 2.0 unweighted GPA and be on track to graduate
- ❖ Must be at least 16 years old
- ❖ Be in either 11th or 12th grade
- ❖ Passed the FSA/ELA or ACT or SAT
- ❖ Passed Algebra I EOC or PERT
- ❖ Satisfactory attendance at current high school
- ❖ No major disciplinary referrals at current high school

## The Process

1. Speak with your high school guidance counselor.
2. Student and counselor must fill out a Fort Myers Technical College Visitation Form and attach required documentation.
3. Return the form to Elaine Petrie, Admissions Officer at FMTC.
4. Student schedules a date to visit FMTC with the admissions officer in order to shadow programs.
5. At the end of the visit, you will meet with an admissions officer. The admissions officer will then determine if you meet the minimum qualifications and requirements to be accepted into FMTC's dual enrollment program.
6. Take the TABE Assessment.
7. If accepted, a parent meeting must be scheduled in order to register for any program. A legal guardian/parent must sign the registration paperwork in order for the student to dual enroll at Fort Myers Technical College.

## Expectations to Maintain Dual Enrollment

- ❖ Maintain 90% attendance rate every semester
- ❖ Maintain satisfactory academic progress (as defined by program)
- ❖ Maintain unweighted overall 2.0 HS GPA
- ❖ Compliance with FMTC's Code of Conduct
