TABE TEST – 2016-2017

Monday – Thursday Register @ 8:00 AM/Test @ 8:30 AM

Tuesday Register @ 4:00 PM/Test @ 4:30 PM

(Complete Battery Tests are offered only during daytime)

Must register 30 MINUTES prior to the start of the exam: 8:00 A.M./4:00 P.M.

TABE testing takes approximately 90 minutes and requires

- a \$15 fee, no personal checks
- A picture ID
- Minimum age of 16
- TABE results are ready immediately after completion

DO NOT BRING YOUR CELL PHONE INTO THE TESTING ROOM. Cell phones, Electronic Devices, Notes, and/or Calculators are **NOT allowed** in the room. Use of these devices or a ringing/vibrating phone will result in the **INVALIDATION** of your test

The following are the only circumstances from which you can be exempt from taking the TABE:

1. You have an *Associate of Science degree, an Associate of Arts degree* or higher.
2. You **graduated** from a Florida *public* high school since 2007 with a **standard** high school diploma.
3. You **previously took the TABE** at another institution either in Florida or out of state within **two years** of the start date of your program and have appropriate scores for your program of interest.
4. You have **ACT/SAT/PERT/Accuplacer** scores earned within two years of the start date of your program that are equivalent to TABE scores. (See the tech college counselor to confirm this.)
5. You have earned the **GED** *within two years* of the start date of your program.
