

# 165-Hour *Articulated* NURSING ASSISTANT

This program is designed to prepare students for employment as cross trained nursing assistants, health care support workers, patient care assistants, nursing aides and orderlies.

This program offers a broad foundation of knowledge and skills, expanding the traditional role of the nursing assistant for both acute and long term care settings. Students, who complete the 90 hours of basic healthcare worker in this program, will not have to repeat this course in any other Health Science program at FMTC if they decide to continue their education.

## Length of Articulated Nursing Assistant Program:

The Articulated Nursing Assistant program is a planned sequence of 165 hours of instruction consisting of the Health Careers Core and Nursing Assistant Program.

Completion of this program allows students to sit for the state-certified Nursing Assistant exam to become a Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA).
