All tests begin promptly at the times listed above. You must check-in with the front office to obtain a visitor's pass and the directions to the testing center. **Please arrive 15 minutes early to the testing site.** Those arriving late will NOT be permitted to test. NO EXCEPTIONS.

- Calculators are NOT allowed (one is provided within the assessment)
- Bring 2 or more #2 pencils
- Schedule 4 hours to take the test
- Scratch paper will be provided by the testing center

All testers must bring valid (current and not expired) state or federal picture ID (Driver's License, Passport, or Military ID). You will also need your ATI Username and Password.

The ATI TEAS may be repeated after a mandatory 30-day waiting period from the date the last exam was taken. You must also pay the registration fee in order to take the exam again.

Please note: By clicking the "Register" button I agree to test on the selected date. I understand that I am responsible for repaying and rescheduling for a new test in the event that I am unable to attend my scheduled date.
