PLANNING TO ATTEND AFTER I GRADUATE HIGH SCHOOL.

Here's what you will need to gather in order to apply for school:

1. A copy of your Academic History from AFTER 1st semester this year showing you are on-track for a standard diploma. (Ask your counselor for a copy in FEBRUARY so that your 1st semester grades are listed.)
2. TWO ID's from the same parent or guardian. The issued date of each ID MUST be more than 12 months ago! Common options:
 - a. Driver's license
 - b. Voter ID card (This can be checked on-line and printed here:

 - c. Vehicle RegistrationThese are the most common – take a look at our website for the complete list, or email FMTCAdmissions@leeschools.net with questions.
3. You'll need to know your Social Security number.

5. Complete your FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) at www.fafsa.gov

PLANNING TO ATTEND AFTER I GRADUATE HIGH SCHOOL.

1. A copy of qualifying SAT, ACT or TABE scores to show Basic Skills Attainment:
 - a. SAT: Reading 24, Math 24, Writing/Language 25
 - b. ACT: Reading 19, Math 19, English 17
 - c. Other qualifying scores. See BASIC SKILLS REQUIREMENTS for a complete list.
2. TWO ID's from the same parent or guardian. The issued date of each ID MUST be more than 12 months ago! Common options:
 - a. Driver's license
 - b. Voter ID card (This can be checked on-line and printed here:
